Disability Services and Programs for students is responsible for arranging reasonable accommodations for all qualified students with a documented disability. The process for obtaining reasonable accommodations is an interactive one that begins with the student's disclosure of their disability. If you will be attending SBCC in the fall, it is advised that you apply to DSPS prior to April 7th and that you complete your registration with DSPS prior to by April 20th, before the start of DSPS priority Registration (details about completing the DSPS application can be found under How to Apply link, noted below).

All New-to-College students are required to complete the Online Orientation and New Student Class Planning. Students who have taken Dual Enrollment classes are still required to complete the Online Orientation and New Student Class Planning prior to enrolling into classes at SBCC. DSPS Priority Registration cannot be used until both requirements have been completed.

The SBCC Foundation launched the SBCC Promise in fall 2016, providing all local high school graduates with the opportunity to attend SBCC full-time free of charge, for up to two years. DSPS students who maintain their eligibility with the Promise and who are approved for a Reduced Unit Load can enroll in (up to) 60 units over an extended period of time and are not restricted to 2 years of eligibility for The Promise.
